



St. Joseph's College of Arts and Science for Women, Hosur Altruistic Alumnae Association Guest lecture- 2023-2024 - Report






Divyarathna Gandhi, MA, B.Ed, CDE, DIP IN ACCUPUNTURE, a former student of our college and current Beauty and Makeup and Trainer. delivered Artist а comprehensive speech on 15.02.2024 to the students of the Computer Science, BCA. The speech emphasized the importance of in extracurricular activities engaging alongside academic pursuits for holistic development.
