### **36. CYBER CLUB**

On 28.10.2024, an awareness program on Vigilance Awareness was held with Mr. C. Kamalnath Yadav, Chief Manager of the State Bank of India, Mookandapalli Branch, Hosur, and Mr. Mallela Deepak, Manager of Compliance & Risk from the Regional Business Office, Hosur, addressing all students. Awareness Week Pledge-Taking Ceremony under their guidance, emphasizing the importance of integrity and ethical responsibility.

On 03.12.2024, an extension activity on Cyber Security was organized at the Government Girls High School in Seetharam Nagar, Hosur. Ms. S. Bobby and Ms. T.M. Princy, Assistant Professors of Computer Science along with two students, Victoria Monda from III B.C.A 'B' and J.S. Jerisfa from II B.C.A 'A,' conducted the session, benefiting 80 government school students.

On 20.12.2024, an awareness program on Hacking was conducted by Mr. Rajiv Sharma, Founder of Nebula Safe Tech, Hosur, Tamil Nadu. The session was attended by 163 students from II B.Sc. [Computer Science] and II B.C.A, providing them with insights into ethical hacking and cyber security practices.
