### **Cultivation:**

Tabebuia rosea thrives in full sun and well-drained soil, preferring tropical and subtropical climates. It is tolerant of drought once established and can withstand occasional periods of waterlogging.

Tabebuia rosea is cherished for its stunning floral display, making it a popular choice in gardens, parks, and urban landscapes where its vibrant blooms add color and beauty.

#### **Characteristics Feature**

- Size: Tabebuia rosea is a medium sized to large deciduous tree that can reach heights of up to 30 meters (about 98 feet).
- Leaves: The leaves are palmately compound, with usually 5 leaflets that are lanceolate to elliptic, and arranged oppositely along the branches.
- Flowers: The flowers of Tabebuia rosea are trumpet shaped, about 57.5 cm (23 inches) long, and vary in color from light pink to deep rose or magenta. They typically bloom in clusters, covering the tree in a spectacular display during the flowering season.
- Bark: The bark is greyish brown and smooth.
- Fruits: The fruit is a dehiscent capsule, containing numerous small seeds that are dispersed by wind.
