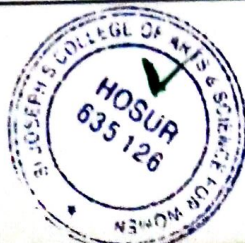

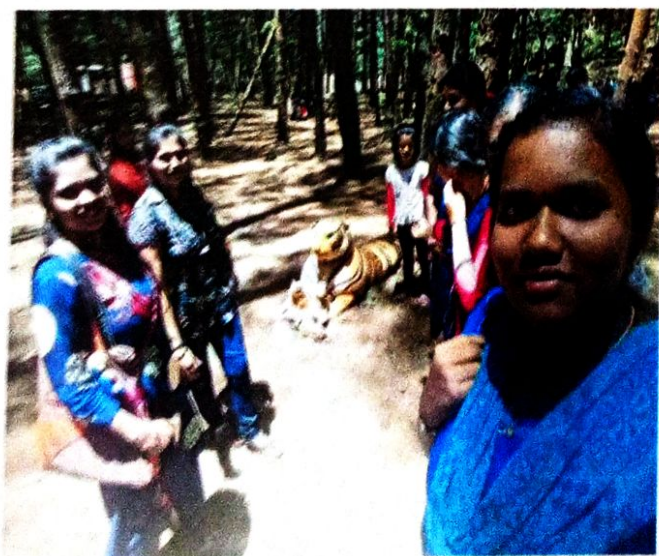

*Report for Tour Visit to Kodaikanal*



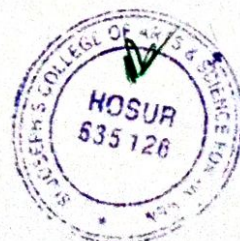
