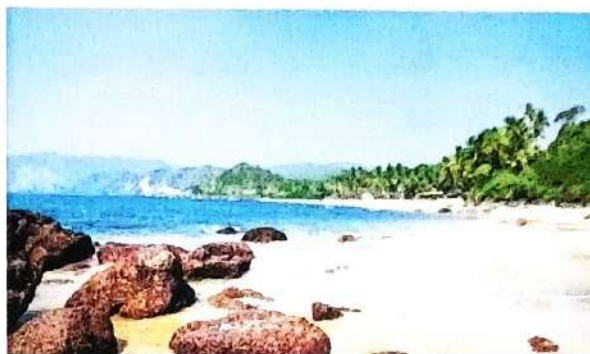
The Tour was organized by Department of Computer Science on 08th Nov 2022 to Goa. Around 58 Students and 5 teachers of Computer Science department were visited.
