

- c) Swamy School of Tailoring, Hosur (hereinafter referred to as Swamy) is a school of fashion designing whose Trainer, Mr. S. Samy focuses on the training of basic stitching of Ladies, Children and Gents.
- d) Swamy School of Tailoring, Hosur (hereinafter referred to as Swamy) is desirous to associate with SJC on various areas as discussed in the purview of this MoU, which will be mutually beneficial to both organizations.

That, relying on the principle of good faith, by virtue of which they will carry out all the possible actions for their due fulfillment,

And relying also on their common bonds and concerns, they state their interest in strengthening their relationships through academic cooperation, and for this end they are of one accord in entering this MoU.

THEREFORE, THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITNESSES AS FOLLOWS

1. OBJECTIVE:

a) The parties agree that the objective of the present MoU is to establish a collaborative relationship between St. Joseph's Arts and Science College and Swamy School of Tailoring, Hosur to provide tailoring training to the college community.

- b) To integrate practical tailoring modules providing students with hands-on experience in addition to theoretical knowledge.
- c) To foster teamwork and creativity in the development of tailor-made clothing or fashion-related initiatives.
- d) St. Joseph's College of Arts and Science for Women, Hosur would allocate appropriate spaces for tailoring classes, ensuring privacy and comfort.
- e) Collaborate with Swamy in supporting the tailoring skills through campus-wide communications and events.
- f) Facilitate access for Swamy staff to engage with students.

4. TERM:

a) This MOU shall be effective for a period of one (1) year from the date of execution of this agreement unless a written notice to terminate or amend these agreements given to the other party six (6) months in advance.

b) It is expressly agreed that neither party shall be liable for damages that they might cause each other as a result of a forceful suspension of a collaboration program. Causes for forceful suspension must be explicitly set forth in the action plans.

c) This agreement may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by either party upon one month's prior notice to the other in writing.

5. CONFIDENTIALITY:

Each of the parties accepts and declares that information from the other party is of confidential nature, is the exclusive property of the latter and has been or will be disclosed to the former solely with the purpose of enabling the full accomplishment of the present Agreement. For this reason, every piece of information provided by one party to the other before signing this Agreement and/or during its performance must be kept confidential and therefore may not be disclosed to any third parties.

6. AMENDMENTS:

The parties may amend or amplify this Agreement through agreements in writing to that effect. Said amendments or additions will be binding on the signatories as of the date of their signature. The parties may not assign, in whole or in part, the performance of the present MOU to any third party, except through prior and express authorization in writing by both of them. And since both parties are in agreement regarding the content of the present document, and as a token of conformity, we sign it in two counterparts, both of which will be considered originals.

Nature Science Foundation, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu, India.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into Coimbatore day of Saturday,11th September, 2021.

BETWEEN

M/s. St. Joseph's College of Arts and Science for Women hereafter "SJCASW", with a registered address at, St. Joseph's College of Arts and Science for Women, Hosur -635126, Tamil Nadu, India affiliated to Periyar University, Salem, Tamil Nadu, India.

AND

M/s. Nature Science Foundation, hereafter "NSF", with a registered address at LIG-II, 2669, Gandhi Managar, Peelamedu, Coimbatore – 641 004, Tamil Nadu, India. SJCASW and NSF are referred to collectively, as "Parties" or individually as "Party."

1. Purpose

The Parties recognize the benefits to be derived from increased collaboration, cooperation and interaction for the further research and development activities on nature conservation and environmental protection (hereafter, collectively referred to as the "Field").

The purpose of this MoU is to define the areas for fundamental, academic research in which the Parties desire to work together in the future for their mutual benefit to foster a collaborative framework between SJCASW and NSF in the Field with a view to benefiting from each other's initiatives and working procedures and to support collaboration among the researchers associated with both Parties.

2. Scope

This MoU sets forth the intentions of the Parties for increased collaboration, cooperation and interaction and does not create any legally binding commitments. If the Parties later agree to undertake specific joint projects with legally binding obligations, they will

develop separate written agreements for such projects, setting out each Party's contributions, deliverables, and budgets.

The parties collaborate, cooperate and interact to achieve the following scopes of this MoU.

- The Parties intend to pursue collaboration on fundamental, academic research, conducting training programme and conference / seminars / workshops related to nature conservation and environmental protection.
- Both parties exchange the technical expertise such as experimental procedures, instrumental knowledge and development of new protocols in the field of Arts, Commerce and Science including some areas in Engineering and Technology.
- 3. Both parties agree to exchange the expertise of their working staff under mutual convenience when requested by either Parties. For example, NSF can request to utilize the expertise of SJCASW staff members for their technical events. However, exchange of faculties or staff members or scientist is to be done under mutual convenience of the Parties when such exchanges doesn't affect the normal functioning of the Parties. During Conferences, Seminars, Symposia and Workshops organized by either Parties, above mentioned exchange of working staff may avail with mutual concerns.
- 4. Both Parties agree to develop collaborative research projects for submitting to various funding agencies in the areas of nature conservation and environmental protection.
- SJCASW can give venues like laboratories and seminar halls to NSF to conduct Conferences, Seminars, Symposia and Workshops on mutual understandings.
- SJCASW can conduct "NSF Annual Meet and Award Distribution Ceremony" and can start "International Eco Club Student Chapter" at SJCASWcampus.
- SJCASW can nominate a few staff coordinators and students to start "International Eco Club Student Chapter" at SJCASW campus.

- SJCASW can nominate one staff coordinator for NSF Advisory Board Committee to improve the activities of NSF in coming days.
- SJCASW can work as an Out station (Branch) of NSF to coordinate the activities of NSF.
- 10. SJCASW can undertake, if interested, "Eco Audit", "Green Campus Audit", "Energy Audit" and "Hygiene Audit: with special discount fees structure with NSF coinciding with the fees collected for 'International Eco Club Student Chapter'.
- 11.If SJCASW is interested to conduct "Lead Auditor Course on Environment Management Systems, Green Campus Audit, Hygiene Audit and Energy Audit" jointly with NSF, it is most welcome to conduct the programme in a big way.
- 12. SJCASW can become an Ordinary/Provisional/Life membership with NSF to avail the benefits of 'Environmental Management Audits', 'International Eco Club Student Chapter' and 'Awards and Honours' (best faculty awards, best scientist awards, best institution awards and Fellow awards) including the conduct of the 'National and International day celebrations'.
- 13. The Students and staff members seeking for financial support to carry out the 'Student Project Scheme' should be a member of the 'International Eco Club Student Chapter' and the Institution should be enrolled with the NSF.
- 14. NSF is promoting R&D work having social relevance, significance and usefulness to our Country in terms of environmental protection and nature conservation.

3. Costs

Each Party will be responsible for its own costs in connection with all matters relating to collaborations under this MoU. Where possible and appropriate, the Parties may also seek funding for collaborations from other Government and private agencies.

4. General Provisions

- 4.1. Treatment of intellectual property rights developed through collaborations under this MoU will be determined between the Parties through mutual consultation and separate written agreements on a case-by-case basis.
- 4.2. Publication credits of any kind arising as a result of this MoU shall be shared by both the Parties. The corresponding authors of the publications would be the Party which has prepared the manuscript. The publications as a result of this MoU will be made under mutual concerns of the Parties while either Parties are intimated verbally.

5. Confidentiality

The parties agree that there is no intention to share any confidential or proprietary information in any collaboration under this MoU. If either Party wishes to disclose information it considers to be confidential or proprietary to the other Party, the Parties will enter into a written non-disclosure agreement.

6. Duration

This MoU shall be effective for a period of FIVE (5) years from the date of final signature. It may be modified or extended by mutual written agreement by the Parties. This MoU may be terminated by either party upon THREE (3) months advance written notice. In witness thereof, the parties hereto signed this agreement to be executed as on the day, month and the year indicated below
