Members of the cell verified the application form submitted by the students for various scholarships for the academic year 2020-2021.

The students are selected for the Post Matric scholarship based on the eligibility criteria of Tamil Nadu Government.

The Eligibility Criteria for minority scholarship is as follows:

- iii. The candidate must not have availed other scholarship.
