PRACTICES:


According to a Supreme Court of India ruling and an announcement from the University Grants Commission (UGC), bullying is defined as one or more of the following: any purpose on the part of a student or group of students to:

- Any disrespectful behavior toward others, including teasing or lack of discipline.
- Any action that impedes or interferes with ordinary academic work.
- Any activity that could lead to irritation, difficulty, psychological damage, or induce anxiety or terror.
- Any act of Force or corruption using payment.
- Any physical abuse act that results in assault, damage, or health risks
- Any kind of vertical abuse, such as insults in public or by emails or SMS.
- Any violation or harm done to a person's basic right to human dignity.
- The use of force by the criminal opposition, trespassing, intimidation, molesting, kidnapping, or commission of unnatural offenses.
- Any illegal gathering or ragging scheme.

Punishments:

- The following penalties may be imposed on any student or group of students found guilty of ragging on campus or even off it:
- Warning, Write an apology letter.
- Loss of academic rights and the inability to attend courses
- Being prohibited from taking the semester-ending exam or any sessional test.
- The institution will not be permitted to participate in any youth festival, competition, meet, or meet at the regional, national, or international levels.
- The hostel may suspend or expel a guest.
- Eliminating other benefits and scholarships
- A dismissal from college
- Cancellation of admission.
- Expungement from the establishment and ensuing banishment from entry into any other establishment for a predetermined duration.
