Report- Guest lecturer in Avoiding Plastic Pollution



Throughout the discourse, participants engaged in a dynamic exchange of ideas, presenting nuanced arguments that underscored both the advantages and disadvantages of shifting consumer preferences.

Students advocating the perspective of consumer behavior being a boon highlighted its positive facets. They accentuated how evolving consumer preferences have stimulated innovation, fostered competition among businesses, and ultimately led to the enhancement of product quality and affordability. 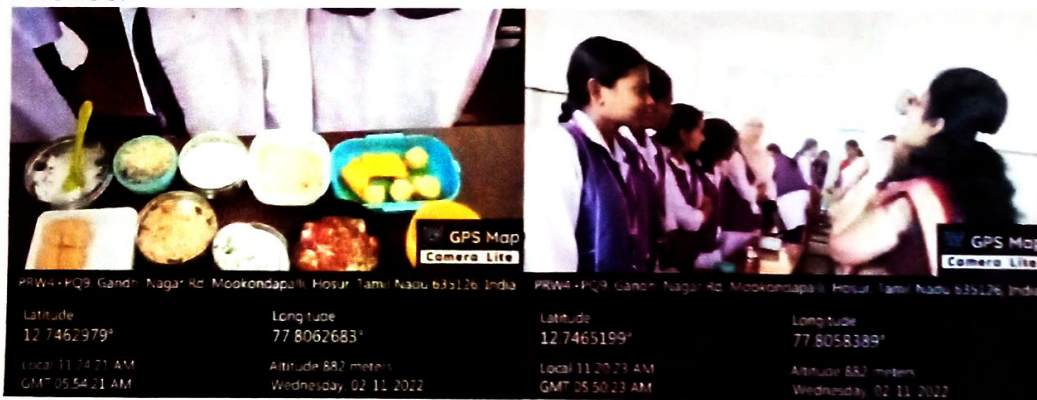
REPORT – FIRELESS COOKING
