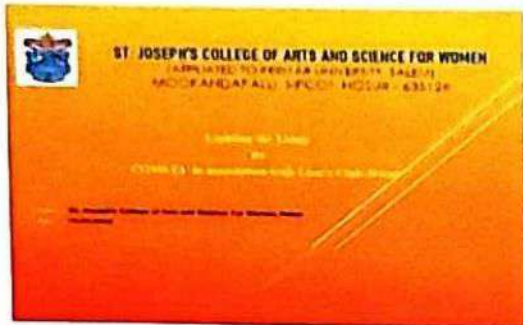

This program was organized with Lion's club to help Government school students to complete their practical syllabus. The students also learned with interest.



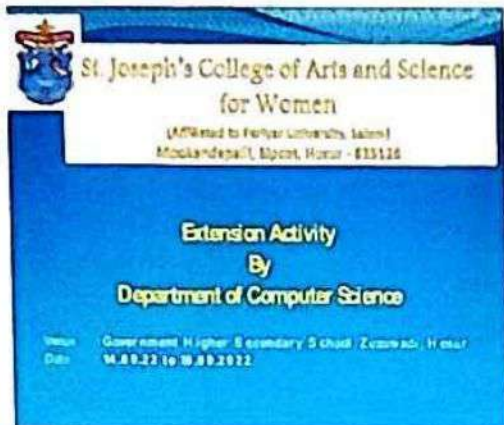
