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## Report

The village of Oddarpalayam is situated in the Hosur taluk of the Krishnagiri district in the Tamil Nadu state of India. The villagers live in a very tranquil way. The primary occupation in this village is agriculture.

The extension program in the hamlet with the topic "Child Labour and Stop Smoking Drinking" was led by the math department students who took the initiative. Throughout the school year, the students made two trips to the village. As part of our extension project, we set out to encourage child labor and Oddarpalayam residents to give up smoking and drinking.

The students in the math department took the lead in organizing the extension program in the hamlet with the theme "Child Labour and Stop Smoking Drinking". The pupils went to the village twice during the academic year. We aimed to promote child labor and the cessation of alcohol and tobacco use among the people residing in Oddarpalayam as part of our extension project.

**Child Labor:** Child labour remains a prevalent issue in many parts of the world, including villages like Oddarpalayam. This report aims to investigate the prevalence and implications of child labour among students of mathematics in the village of Oddarpalayam. Educating local communities, parents, and employers of the detrimental effects child labor has on children's general wellbeing, education, and physical and mental health. Raising public knowledge of national and international regulations and agreements, such as those of the International Labour Organization (ILO) and national labor laws, that forbid child labor. 

Pyarakanahally is a village situated 5 km away from our college. People of this village live in a very peaceful manner. Agriculture is the main profession of this village. **Date: July 7, 2019, and December 8, 2019**

On July 7, 2019, and December 8, 2019, students from St. Joseph's College of Arts and Science for Women, specifically from the Department of Nutrition and Dietetics, undertook an extension activity in Dinnur village. The primary objective was to promote awareness of healthy food choices and nutrition among the villagers. During the two-day activity, various initiatives were implemented to engage the community and disseminate knowledge on healthy eating habits. 

**Theme of the Extension Activity:** Creating awareness on Biofertilizer cultivation- Azolla

**Venue:** Vadrapallayam

**Date:** 28.07.2019 and 05.01.2020

The Department of Biotechnology organized an extension activity in Vadrapallayam on July 28, 2019, and January 5, 2020, with the theme of creating awareness on biofertilizer cultivation, focusing on Azolla. The objective was to educate villagers about the benefits of Azolla as a sustainable and eco-friendly alternative to chemical fertilizers.

During the two-day activity, various initiatives were undertaken to engage the community and disseminate knowledge about Azolla cultivation. Interactive sessions were conducted to explain the process of cultivating Azolla and its role in improving soil fertility and crop productivity. Participants were provided with hands-on training on setting up Azolla beds and maintaining optimal growth conditions. Furthermore, demonstration plots were established in the village to showcase successful Azolla cultivation practices. Villagers were encouraged to adopt Azolla cultivation in their agricultural practices to reduce dependency on chemical fertilizers and promote sustainable farming methods. The impact of the extension activity was evident in the increased awareness and adoption of Azolla cultivation among the villagers. Many farmers reported improvements in soil health and crop yields after incorporating Azolla into their farming practices. The village of Berakapalli is located 18 kilometers from Hosur. The villagers live in great harmony with one another. This village's primary occupation is agriculture. There's a primary school in the village.

The Department of Computer Science's III B.Sc(CS) students took the lead in organizing the extension activity in the village with the theme "Promoting Online Banking and Combatting Banking Fraud." Throughout the academic year, the students made two trips to the village. We started a campaign to encourage online banking and educate Berakapalli residents about banking-related frauds as part of our extension activity.

Our main objective was to provide Berakapalli residents with the information and abilities they needed to safely use online banking services. We offered hands-on examples and instructional guides on how to use banking software and online payment systems in order to make online banking more understandable. Some of the villagers had little experience with technology and found it difficult to use online banking services. Unreliable internet access in some places made it difficult for people to use online banking services.
