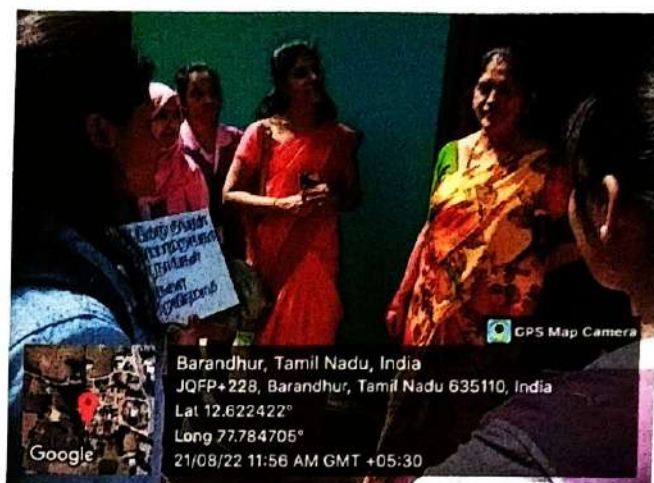

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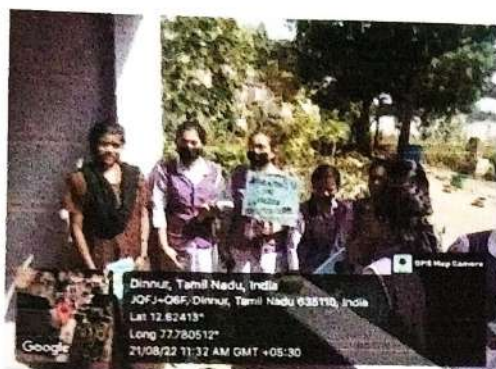

2. **Poverty and Unemployment**


Recommendations

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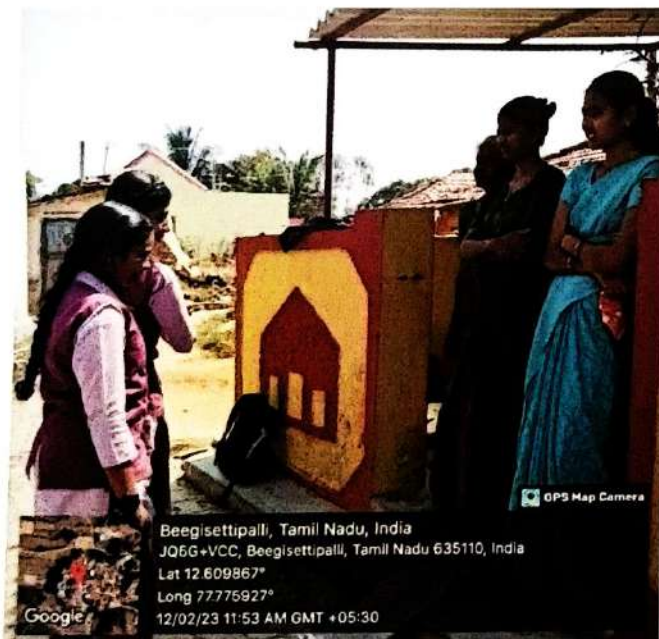

Report

Vadrapallyam is a village situated 12 km away from Hosur. The Village was very small with a very little population. Agriculture is the main profession of this village. The students of III and II-B.Sc. Biotechnology, from the Department of Biotechnology took initiative in conducting the extension activity in the village on the theme "Creating awareness about Biofertilizer Cultivation-Azolla". The students went to the village twice during the academic year. As part of our extension activity, we took our goal to save the nature and the environment to promote the use and benefits of natural fertilizers among the residents of Vadrapallyam.


Our primary goal was to promote and implement the use of natural fertilizer as an alternative for chemical fertilizer to avoid soil pollution and enhance the growth of agricultural crops. We provided practical demonstrations to cultivate Azolla and provided the residents a few samples which we have already cultivated in the college campus. Azolla is not only a Biofertilizer that can be used for crops, but it can also be used as feed for cattle. Since many of the houses are provided with cattle, the people of Vadrapallyam felt this as a very useful feed for crops as well as cattle. The people understood the benefits of Azolla and they gained a very useful idea on alternative fertilizer which is harmless to plants and animals.

Our extension activity in Vadrapallyam village was very satisfying as it inculcated the use of natural products which are not harmful to the environment, by which the nature and beauty of the village is restored. By creating awareness to the villagers with knowledge of cultivating and using natural fertilizer, we have emphasized the importance of the natural resources and saving the environment for our future generations.


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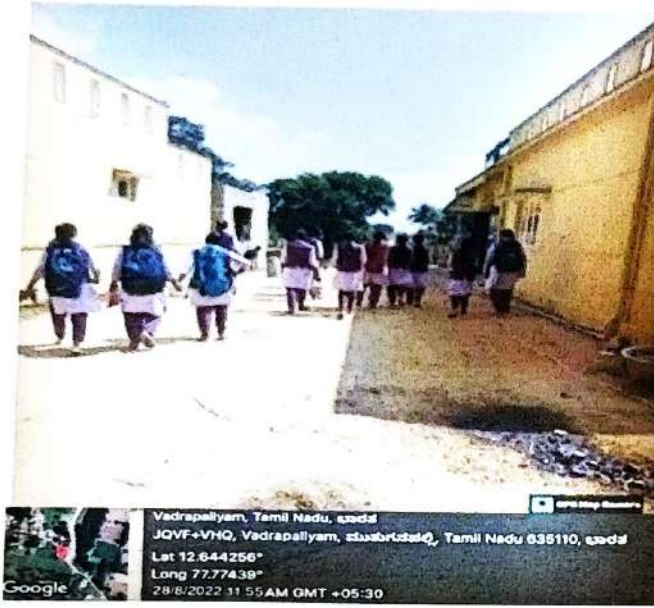

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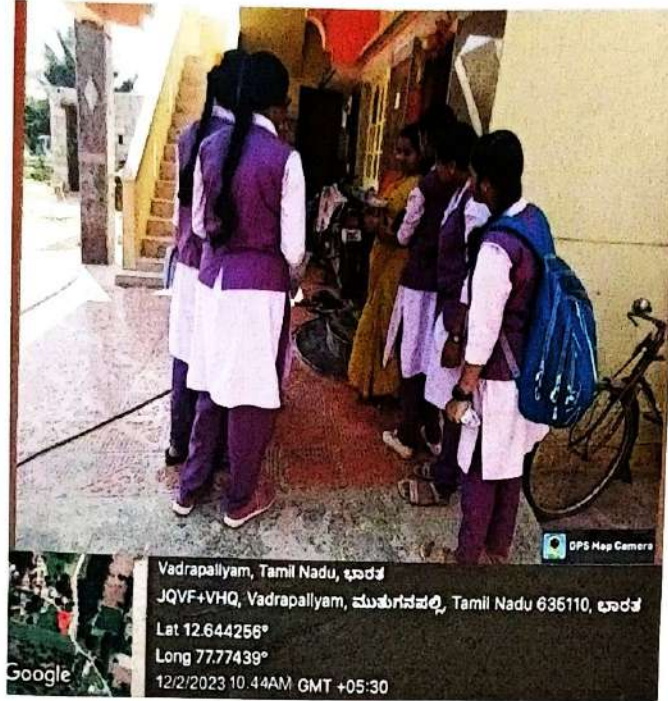

Report

Upon arrival in Perakkapalli, Hosur, we were warmly welcomed by the locals who were eager to learn and engage with us. The activity commenced with an interactive session highlighting the adverse impacts of plastic pollution on the environment, wildlife, and human health. Report



Our main objective was to teach writing and provide the people of B.chettipalli with knowledge. Special focus was given to adult literacy classes, targeting individuals who never had the opportunity to attend school. Covering subjects like menstrual health, how to use napkins properly, disposal techniques, and the significance of maintaining hygiene throughout periods were our main objectives.
