



This two-day workshop was specially designed to introduce high school students from government schools to the dynamic and

The sessions began with an interactive introduction to the concepts of IoT, including its definition, significance,



and examples of real-world use cases. This was followed by an overview of core IoT components such as sensors, actuators, connectivity modules, and data processing units.



Students were introduced to Arduino kits, along with basic electronic components like LEDs, resistors, jumper wires, and breadboards. Hands-on learning formed the heart of the workshop, as students engaged in stimulating activities like blinking LED setups, traffic light simulation, motion detection and alarm systems, smart irrigation systems, smart dustbin monitoring, driver drowsiness detection systems, and radar-based toll gate control.

A unique and impactful feature of this workshop was the **group-based teaching** approach. Student volunteers from the Department of Computer Science – including students from III B.Sc. CS and II B.C.A. –

played a vital role in mentoring the school students.







The Cyber Club In Association with Innovation and Incubation Centre of St. Joseph's College of Arts and Science for Women organized an Workshop on "Virtual Talk on Cyber Hygiene- A brainstorming workshop to propose innovative cyber security solutions on 27th February at 10:00 a.m.. The event aimed to educate students and faculty members on essential cybersecurity practices and provide a

platform for brainstorming innovative solutions to enhance online security. The session was graced by the presence of renowned cybersecurity expert Mr. Rushikesh Handore B.E., Project Associate at CDAC Bangalore.



The event aimed to raise awareness about cyber hygiene and the importance of cybersecurity in daily online interactions. It highlighted risks like identity theft, socially engineering, and deepfake technology.

Students learned best practices for digital 351

security, including password management and phishing prevention. Mobile security and email safety were key focus areas. The department of English, Mathematics and Computer Science department students all first year are Participated

The session encouraged innovative solutions to combat cyber threats. Ethical and responsible online behavior was emphasized. Ultimately, the event promoted a secure and informed digital community.



During the session, Mr. Rushikesh Handore discussed six critical aspects of cybersecurity, providing real-world examples and effective preventive measures to enhance cyber hygiene. The session focused on identity theft, password management, mobile security, social engineering, deepfakes, and email security, helping attendees understand modern cyber threats and how to mitigate them.

The session covered identity theft, where cybercriminals steal personal data for fraud. Phishing scams trick users into revealing sensitive information. Data breaches, card skimming, and social media exploitation were highlighted as major risks. Hackers steal information through fake emails, ATM devices, and public profiles. Mr. Handore stressed avoiding online data sharing and two-factor enabling authentication Regularly checking bank statements and using credit monitoring services were recommended. These measures help protect against identity theft effectively.

Weak or reused passwords make accounts vulnerable to cyberattacks. Best practices include using strong, unique passwords with a mix of characters and storing them in a password manager. Regular updates and enabling multi-factor authentication (MFA) enhance security. Mobile security is crucial as smartphones are used for banking, shopping, and communication. Threats include malware apps, public Wi-Fi risks, and SIM swapping. Users should install apps from trusted sources, use VPNs, and keep software updated. Enabling remote lock and data wipe features helps protect lost or stolen devices. Social engineering manipulates individuals into revealing personal information through phishing, pretexting, baiting, and tailgating. To stay safe, users should verify requests, be cautious of urgent messages, and use email filters. Avoid clicking on suspicious links to prevent cyber threats.



The session covered deepfakes, where AI-generated videos or audio spread misinformation, fraud, and impersonation. Examples include fake political videos, CEO voice scams, and fraudulent celebrity endorsements. Users can detect deepfakes by spotting unnatural expressions, lip-sync issues, and

using reverse image searches. Email security was also discussed, highlighting threats like phishing, ransomware, and spoofing. Best practices include avoiding unknown emails, verifying links, using spam filters, and enabling encryption.

In association with innovation and incubation centre. A brainstorming workshop to propose innovative cybersecurity solutions. The students are discussed with following points.

AI-Powered Phishing Detection System, Develop a machine learning-based browser extension that detects phishing websites in real time and integrates AI to analyze email patterns for phishing detection. Blockchain-Based Digital Identity Verification, develop a blockchain-based decentralized digital identity system with zero-knowledge proofs for secure, passwordless authentication and identity theft prevention.



Passwordless Authentication with Biometrics & Blockchain, authentication system using biometric encryption and blockchain to prevent credential leaks. Cyber Hygiene Awareness Gamification, design a mobile app or VR-based game to educate users on cybersecurity threats and best practices.

Secure Cloud Storage Using Homomorphic Encryption Enable secure computations on encrypted cloud data without decryption, ensuring privacy in cloud-based AI applications. Build an AI-powered threat intelligence platform that monitors the dark web for leaked credentials and security breaches.



Finally, the Virtual Talk on "Cyber Hygiene" was a resounding success, fulfilling its goal of spreading awareness about cybersecurity risks and best practices. The session covered essential topics such as Identity Theft, Password Management, Mobile Security, Social Engineering, Deepfakes, and Email Security, equipping students with practical knowledge to protect themselves online. s cyber threats continue to evolve, institutions must take proactive steps to educate students about digital security. The Cyber Club looks forward to organizing more such sessions in the future, fostering a culture of cybersecurity awareness and responsible digital citizenship.

Sr. Dr. Dona Grace Jeyase Principal Secretary The Women's Cell and Rural Women Welfare Club, in association with the Genesis Innovation & Incubation Centre of St. Joseph's College of Arts and Science for Women, Hosur, organized a community extension activity titled "Wings of Wellness — Training on Sanitary Napkin Making" on January 4, 2025, at Pyarakanahally village.

This initiative was designed to empower rural women by equipping them with practical knowledge and skills in making hygienic, low-cost sanitary napkins. Unlike previous initiatives that focused on awareness and distribution, this program emphasized sustainable menstrual hygiene management by enabling women to produce their own sanitary products.



The event commenced with a short awareness session highlighting importance of menstrual hygiene and the adverse effects of using unsafe alternatives. Following this, a hands-on training session was conducted where participants learned to create sanitary napkins using simple, eco-friendly, and locally available materials. The process included step-bystep demonstrations of assembling, sterilizing, and packaging the napkins. Special focus was given to maintaining cleanliness and safety during production and disposal.



The program also introduced the women to basic tools and encouraged the use of lowinvestment methods for starting homebased or group-led production. The trainers explained how such skills could be transformed into a source of income by forming self-help groups (SHGs) or small-



scale enterprises. The session sparked meaningful discussions about menstrual health, broke common social taboos, and encouraged women to speak openly about their needs and concerns.



Overall, the training instilled confidence, enhanced awareness, and promoted economic self-reliance among the participants. The college, through this initiative, reaffirmed its commitment to community welfare, skill development, and women's empowerment.



The program left a lasting impact by promoting health, dignity, and sustainable livelihood practices in rural communities.
