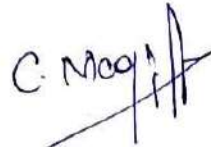
Moreover, the seminar underscored the importance of holistic approaches to sustainable development, emphasizing the interconnectedness of the built environment with broader
