Grievance cell Report

- On January 5, 2022, students chair-person voiced for two-wheeler parking shed representing the students need. A discussion on parking ensued during a meeting by the Principal and Staff Secretary with the Heads of the Departments. Subsequently, the problem was resolved by arranging for the construction of a two-wheeler shed, scheduled for completion by March 2022. These proactive measures demonstrate the institution's commitment to enhancing both academic resources and campus facilities for student convenience and welfare.
- > Students voiced concerns about the inadequate timings for taking printouts and xerox issues at the office, leading to difficulties in completing work on time due to long queues at the Xerox printer on February 24, 2022. The issue was addressed in a meeting organized by the Principal and Staff Secretary, involving staff members. The meeting concluded with a decision to establish a separate shop for photocopying services from March 2022 onwards. This proactive solution aims to alleviate the bottleneck at the office's printer, providing students with improved access to printing facilities and ensuring smoother workflow for academic tasks.
