
The resource person then conducted an open ended questionnaire in the seminar hall to make the students to participate in business ideas which motivated all the students to bring their own ideas of business.



To spread awareness on the importance of Indian innovation and the value of Indian education in our society.


REPORT:







The training session concluded with the National Anthem.












PROFILE OF THE RESOURCE PERSON:

The resource person gave a brief note on different innovative design thinking projects which are available already. She encouraged the students to think and create innovative projects. She motivated the students to think effectively.


The session was so interesting and the students understood the importance of design thinking. Pricy of I B.C.A delivered the vote of thanks.




