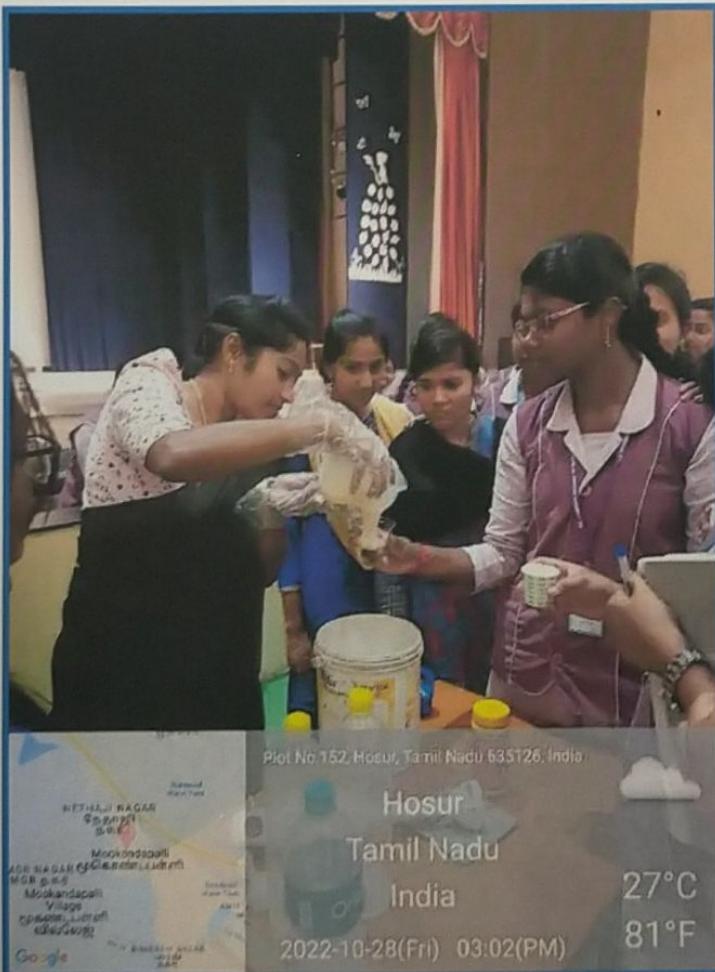
The resource person then conducted a hands-on training session of making soaps and detergents. The participants too were given raw materials to concoct as per her instructions.

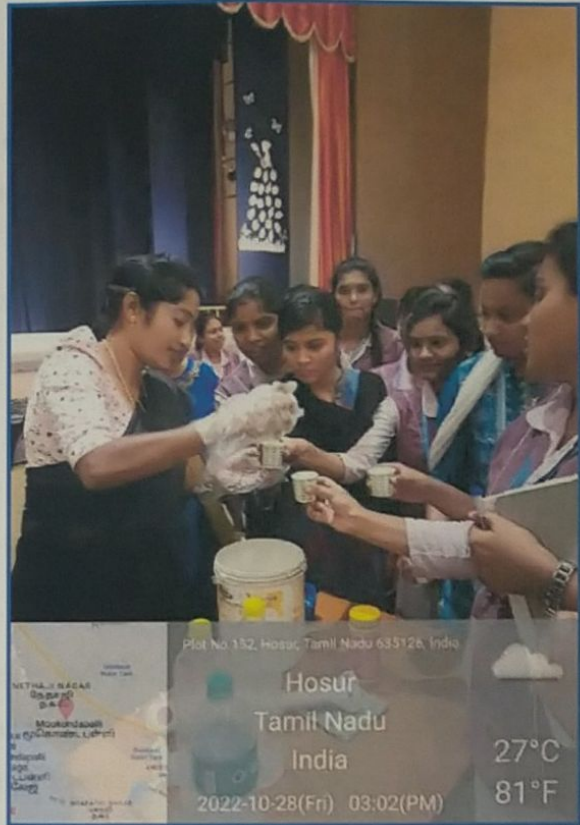

She has also attended various UGC sponsored coferences and national and international level conference, seminars and symposium. She has pulished various journals andpapers in various publications.

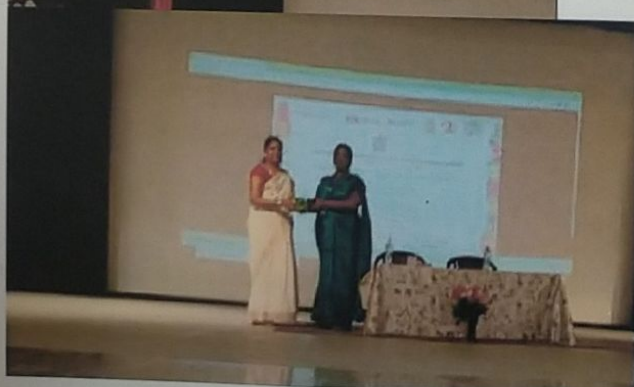
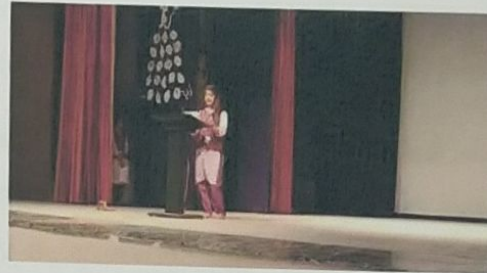
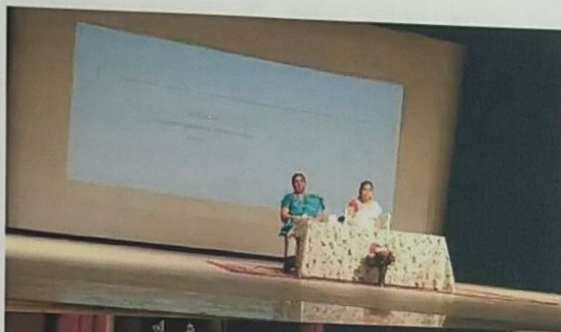
REPORT:

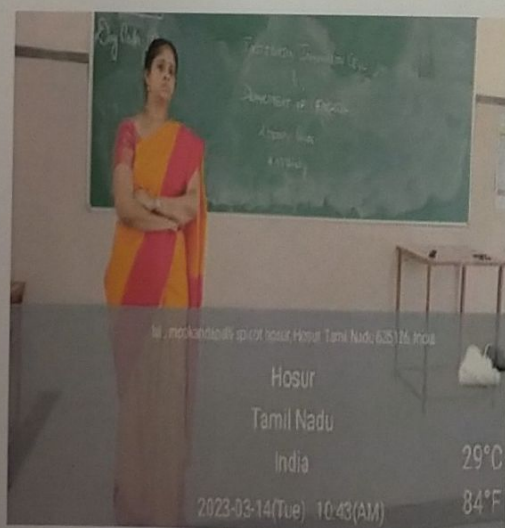
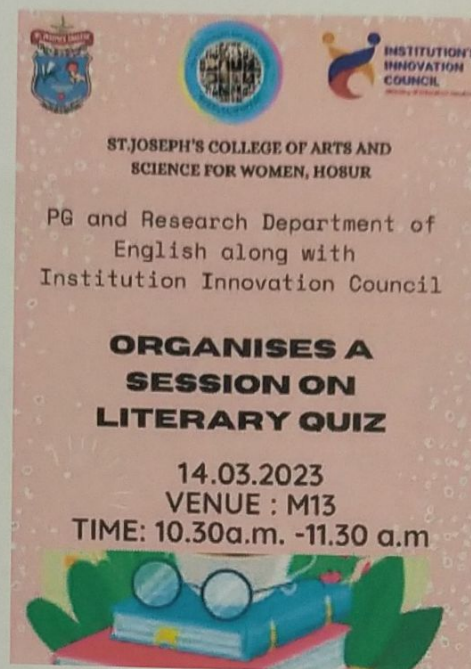
PROFILE OF THE RESOURCE PERSON:

At the end of the training session all the student participants successfully made soft toys. They were elated and professed in their feedbacks that they have learned a way to become little entrepreneurs and earn while studying.

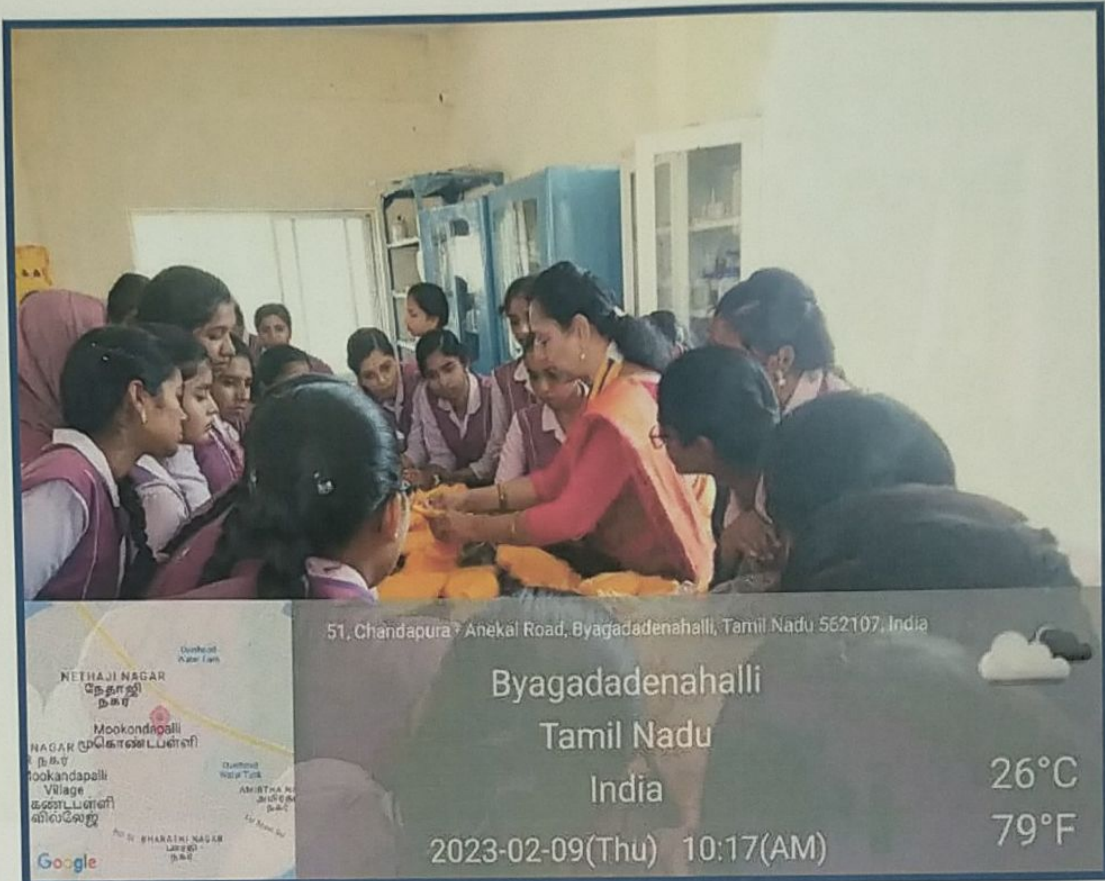
