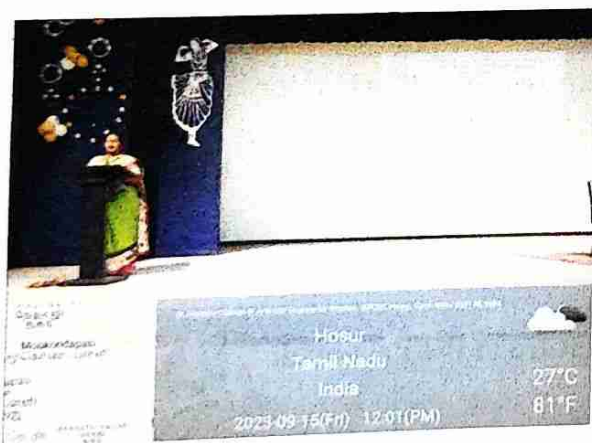

Ms. M. Shobana Priya, Asst professor, Dept of Mathematics presented the welcome address.

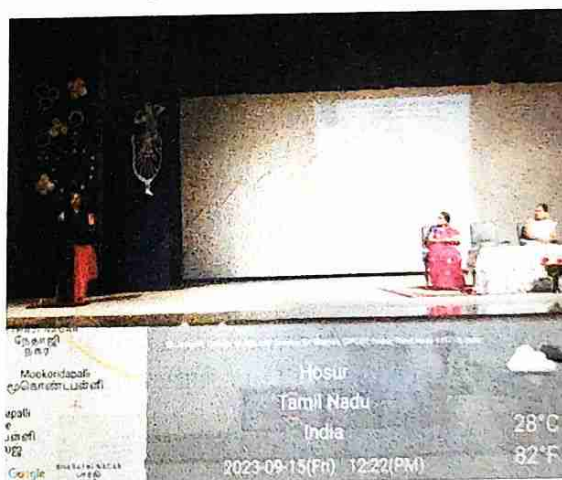

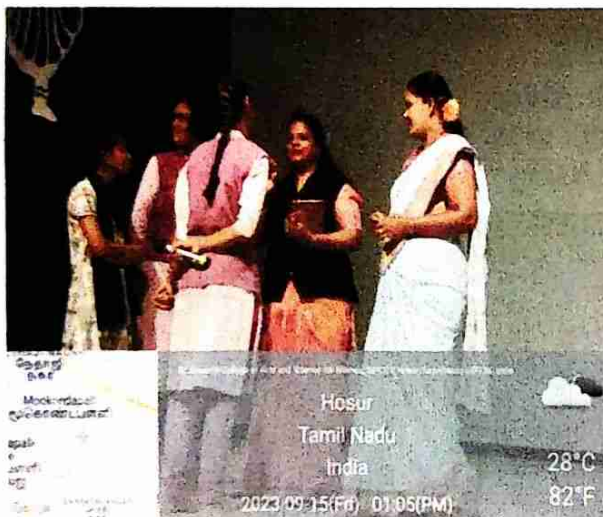
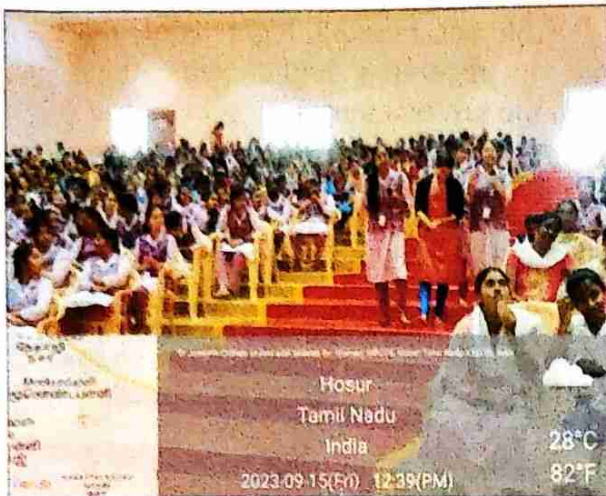
under POCSO act, ragging, legal problems and aids in receiving higher education fund from the government.

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Report for Seminar on "Achieving Excellence in Higher Education through NAAC Accreditation" – 19th Aug' 2023

The Seminar on "Achieving Excellence in Higher Education through NAAC Accreditation" was organized by IQAC, on 19th August, 2023. Dr. Priya Narayanan, Assistant Adviser at the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in Bengaluru, Karnataka, served as the resource person.



Dr. Priya Narayanan provided a comprehensive overview of the NAAC accreditation process, emphasizing its significance in enhancing institutional quality and accountability. She elaborated on the stages of accreditation, including Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA), Self Study Report (SSR) submission, and Peer Team Visits. Dr. Narayanan also shared valuable insights on effective SSR preparation, focusing on data collection, documentation, and addressing the seven criteria: Curricular Aspects, Teaching-Learning and Evaluation, Research, Innovations, and Extension, Infrastructure and Learning Resources, Student Support and Progression, Governance, Leadership, and Management, and Institutional Values and Best Practices.



Dr. Priya highlighted the crucial role of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) in ensuring continuous quality improvement and the importance of stakeholder involvement in the accreditation process. Participants gained practical strategies for overcoming common challenges and enhancing institutional standards.



The seminar concluded with an interactive Q&A session, where attendees had the opportunity to clarify doubts and discuss specific aspects of the accreditation process. The event was well-received, with participants appreciating the depth of knowledge shared and expressing interest in further training sessions on accreditation.

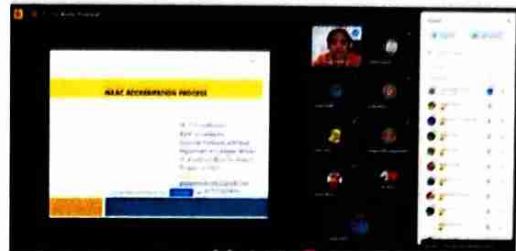

The webinar began with an introduction to NAAC accreditation, highlighting its significance in ensuring quality and accountability in higher education institutions. The benefits of accreditation, such as enhanced institutional credibility, improved academic standards, and better funding opportunities, were discussed in detail. The session then moved on to explain the NAAC assessment and accreditation process, covering the eligibility criteria and the seven stages: Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA), Self Study Report (SSR) submission, Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS), Data Validation and Verification (DVV), Peer Team Visit, and Accreditation Outcome.



A significant portion of the webinar was dedicated to SSR preparation. The speakers emphasized the importance of SSR in the accreditation process, as it reflects the institution's self-evaluation. They explained the structure of the SSR, detailing the seven criteria: Curricular Aspects, Teaching-Learning and Evaluation, Research, Innovations, and Extension, Infrastructure and Learning Resources, Student Support and Progression, Governance, Leadership, and Management, and Institutional Values and Best Practices.



The webinar concluded with a summary of key points and actionable steps for institutions aiming for NAAC accreditation. Participants were encouraged to utilize the resources and support available through NAAC and to maintain a focus on continuous improvement in quality and standards.

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
