

Throughout the event, discussions centred on the nutritional value of coconut and its potential contributions to a balanced diet. Experts emphasized the rich content of vitamins,


minerals, and healthy fats found in coconut, which can support overall health and well-being when incorporated into meals mindfully.








The students from all the departments celebrated the day with Pongal preparation and students recited Tamil poems and danced for folk songs. The Pongal prepared was distributed to all the students.

#### **Republic Day Celebration**










Alumni members shared important issues of elder abuse awareness, and accessing healthcare services.

#### **DRUG AWARENESS**






#### ORGAN DONATION DAY

# **PHOTOGRAPHY EXPO 2022**








#### NATIONAL POLLUTION CONTROL DAY 2022 - 2023
