DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE

POLICY:

- Establishing a secure and inspiring atmosphere within our establishment and fostering professionalism in students through the implementation of optimal methodologies.
- To create mechanisms to control student behavior and to work toward the prevalence of a healthy atmosphere by enforcing discipline among students on campus.
- To raise awareness about inappropriate behavior and to stop any undesirable events from happening on campus.
- To offer a channel by which the committee can keep an eye on and manage the behavior of its students.

PRACTICES:

- The committee's mission is to keep the college campus disciplined and to enforce it.
- While on campus and in their classes, all students are required to carry their ID cards.
- Should a rule infringement be discovered, the student's ID card will be seized and returned to them that same day, along with a warning from the members of the disciplinary committee.
- The committee makes sure that the auditorium is silent and that rules are followed during the General Assembly.
- The committee and the tutors in the classes will limit the amount of time that students spend using their phones on college property.
- The committee makes sure that all of the pupils arrive at class on time.
- During college business hours, the committee keeps an eye on student behavior and forbids them from hanging out in the corridors.
 - The committee ensures that there is total quiet among students in the library.
- The Disciplinary Committee shall collect the cost of any damage that a student or group of students causes to college property, along with a fine, from the offending student or group.
- The students will receive a warning the first time the committee discovers any instances of misbehavior. Discipline according to the committee's policies and procedures will be applied if the misbehavior pattern persists.

OUTCOMES:

- Students are encouraged by the committee to assume personal accountability for their behavior and education.
- The committee develops youth to become mature, contributing members of society. The committee makes sure that every student is aware of the college and campus rules and regulations.
- The committee makes sure that the college's programs are conducted with strict discipline.
- The committee investigates and intervenes to stop any infractions of the dress code, misbehavior toward staff and students, and tardiness or late arrival.
