The first meeting of the Cell was convened on 05-10-2020 at Principal room. Dr (Sr.) Arockiarani I, The principal and the minority cell members discussed about the procedures in connection with the scholarship schemes of state and central government. Members of the cell verified the application form submitted by the students for various scholarships for the academic year 2020-2021.

The students are selected for the Post Matric scholarship based on the eligibility criteria of Tamil Nadu Government.

The Eligibility Criteria for minority scholarship is as follows:

- i. A minimum score of 50% in both classes x and xii.
- ii. The annual household income is 2.5 lakhs per annum or lesser.
- iii. The candidate must not have availed other scholarship.

81 students enrolled the Post Matric Minority Scholarship. Total amount of Rs. 200100/- was disbursed as grant to 32 students those who are eligible.
