Item No. BOS. EN.25_26.1.01: Discussion on the scheme for all the 6 semesters of B. A. English and all the 4 semesters of M. A. English

The scheme of examinations and distribution of courses across the six semesters of B. A. English and the 4 semesters of M. A. English were presented.

• Suggestions Received:

- o Credits and hour allotment are well structured.
- o Comprehensive courses are designed for both UG and PG.
- o The scheme is well framed according to the norms of the Periyar University.

Resolution:

 The scheme was reviewed and approved for implementation with minor realignments.

Item No. BOS.EN.25_26.1.02: Review and approval of the proposed syllabus of I and II semesters (B.A. English, M.A. English and General / Advanced English) including POs, PSOs, COs, credits, Text books and Reference books.

The draft syllabus for I and II semesters along with Program Outcomes (POs),
 Program Specific Outcomes (PSOs), Course Outcomes (COs), credits, textbooks, and
 reference books was presented.

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- Suggestions Received:
 - The syllabus of both UG and PG are well designed and carefully executed in the courses with mapping of POs and PSOs. Few changes - (Swayam Courses can be brought in Semester III, Technical Writing course can be introduced, English for Documentation as SEC) for further development.
 - Few hours of General / Advanced English could be utilised for Library reference.
- Resolution: The Board of Studies resolved that the UG and PG syllabi are welldesigned. For further improvement, it was suggested to introduce a Technical Writing course and offer Digital English for Documentation as SEC. It was also noted that SWAYAM courses are already mandatory and require no change in placement.

Item No. BOS.EN.25_26.1.03: To review the Equivalence Matrix prepared for the Autonomous syllabus in comparison with the University syllabus, ensuring academic parity and compliance with university norms.

- The Board examined the Equivalence Matrix prepared to map the Autonomous syllabus with that of the University, ensuring smooth transition and credit transfer for students.
- Suggestions Received: The team ensured greater alignment of course content and credits. The Board expressed satisfaction that the mapping upholds both institutional autonomy and university standards effectively. It was decided to increase the lecture hours of History of English Literature to 4 hours per week; to retain Digital English for Documentation as Allied Practical.
- Resolution: The Board reviewed and approved the Equivalence Matrix of the Autonomous syllabus, recommending it for submission to the Academic Council for further approval.

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









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
