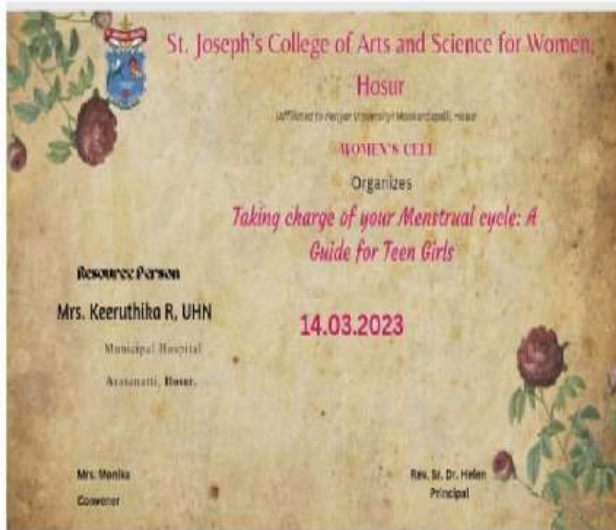

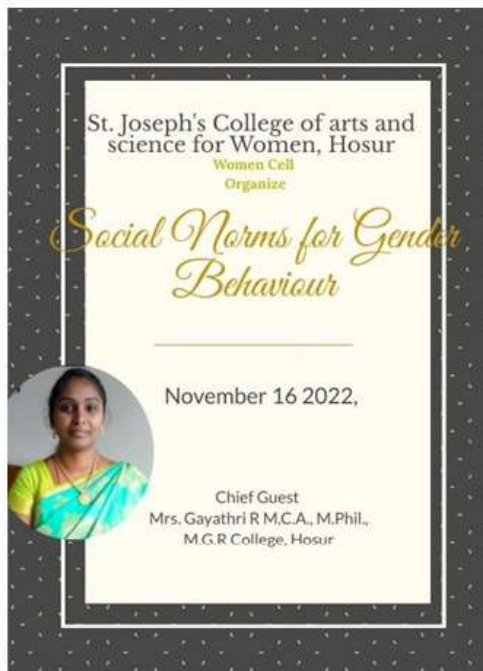
Taking Charge of Menstrual Cycle: A Guide for Teen Girls

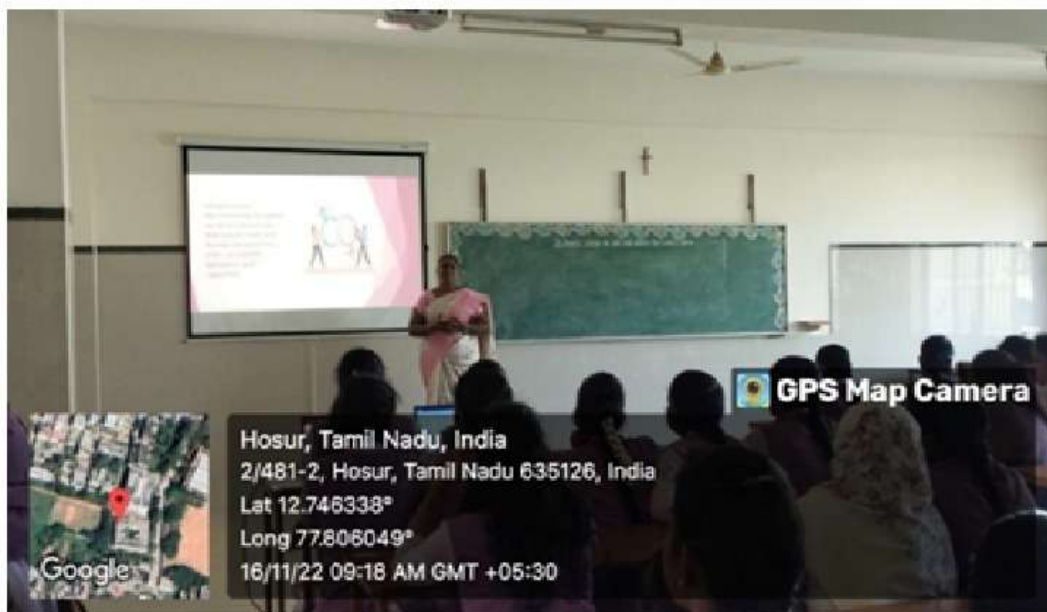
