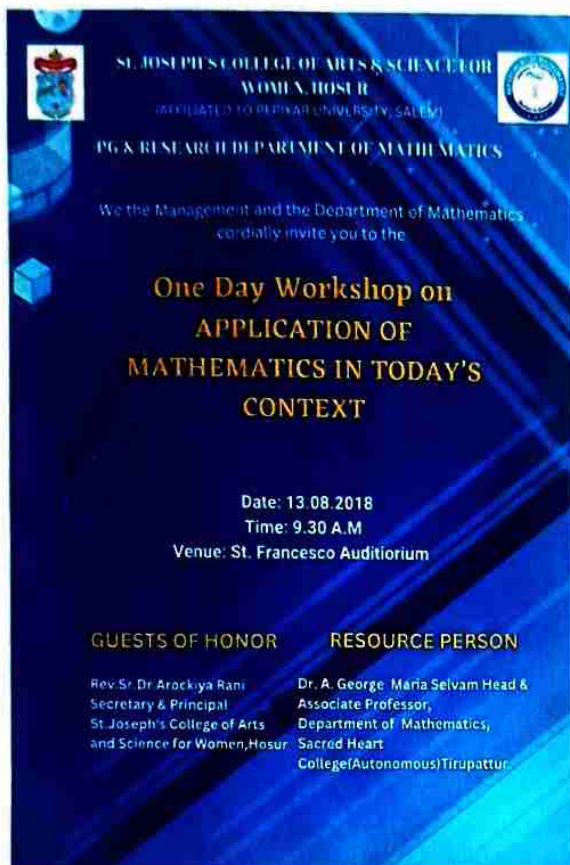

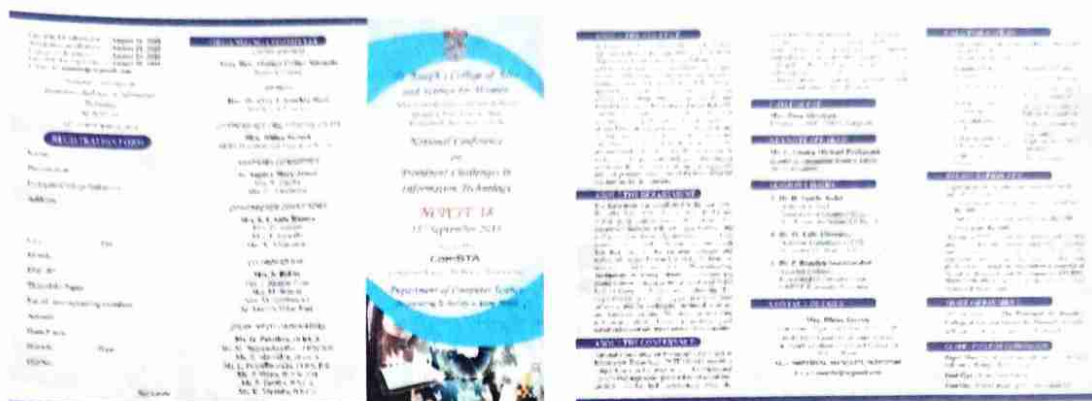

60 Papers received and around 31 members presented their papers. Finally best papers are selected and awarded on that day.

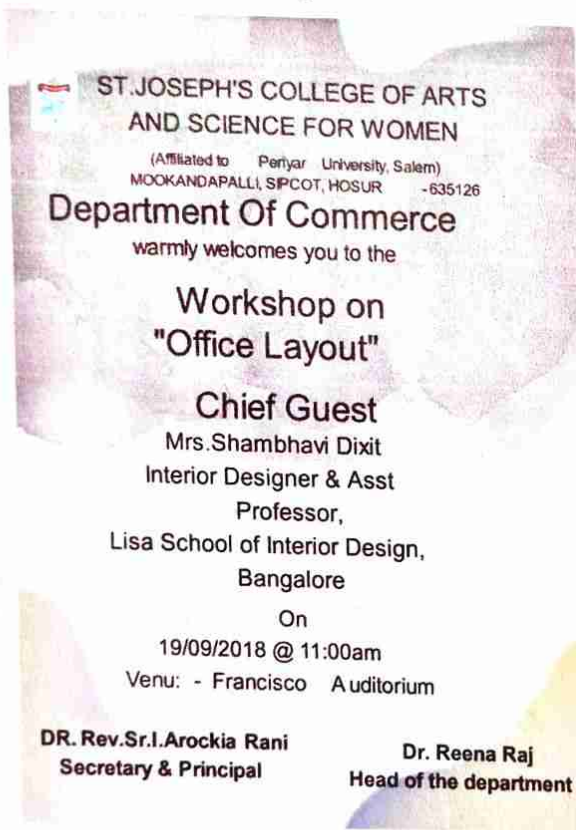

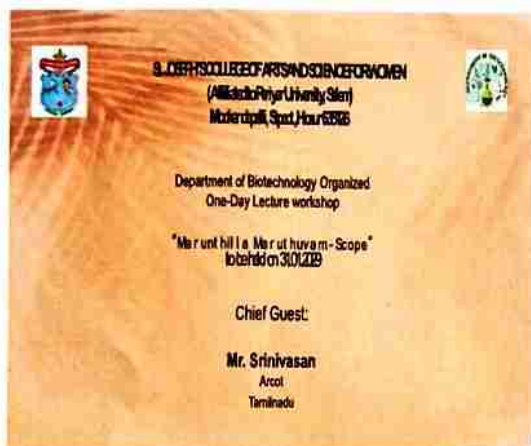
