



Welcome and Resource Person introduction was given by








Mrs.B.K.Jaleesha, Asst.Professor & Head, Department of Mathematics.

We had 200 participants on the first day.




Finally the first day session ends with a thanks giving speech by Mrs.T.Mahalakshmi, Asst.Professor, Department of Mathematics.







A one day workshop is organized to explore knowledge in excel advanced features.




The aim of this workshop is to expose the students to tools of MS-EXCEL that are necessary for data handling. The students of III BCA has participated in this workshop.


