


Report:





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
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Report for **EDP** – “Candle & Keychain Making”

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







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DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

Report on EDC- Basic Cuttings


A One day seminar on EDC- Basic cuttings was conducted on 28 . 04. 2023. The resource person were S.Asshifa and O.Obulakshmi, Trainers of AARA DESIGNING SCHOOL OF FASHION TECHNOLOGY.

The hands-on session focusing on basic cutting and stitching techniques in tailoring provided participants with essential skills for garment construction and alteration.



The participants got familiarity about essential cutting tools and their uses in tailoring and they developed proficiency in identifying fabric grainlines and laying out patterns accurately.

Also, the students acquired basic cutting skills and fundamental stitching techniques, including hand stitching and machine stitching. Essential skills and confidence to pursue further study or embark on their own tailoring projects were gained from this training programme..



Participants were introduced to basic cutting techniques, including straight cuts, curved cuts, and notching, with hands-on practice exercises using fabric scraps. They were instructed about fundamental stitching techniques, including hand stitching, machine stitching, and seam finishing methods such as serging or zigzag stitching.
